### **GUIDELINES for the SUBMISSION of APPLICATIONS**

Canadian Parents for French (Ontario) established the **W.R. McGillivray Award** in 1986 as a special tribute to the memory of Russ McGillivray and the outstanding contribution he made to the development of bilingual education. Russ McGillivray was a Superintendent of Schools and a Superintendent of Program with the Carleton Board of Education. His special focus was in the area of bilingual education. He played a leading role in the initial development and growth of early and late immersion programs in the Carleton Board. As well, he advised numerous boards of education on French Second-Language (FSL) programs and lectured on the topic throughout North America. He is the author of several articles on many aspects of FSL education and was a special friend to CPF Ontario.

CPF Ontario is seeking award nominations for a person currently in a position of responsibility in education who has shown initiative, leadership and commitment in promoting the development of FSL learning in Ontario. For example, a nominee may be a school board administrator, coordinator, school principal, vice-principal, department head or teacher.
