

## **Application to the CPF Ontario Board of Directors**

Persons may be nominated to the CPF Ontario Board of Directors as follows:

- A Nomination by a Chapter
  - A Chapter may nominate a candidate for a position on the Board by forwarding the name of the potential candidate to the Nominating Committee up to eight (8) weeks prior to the date of the Annual General Meeting (AGM) in any given year.
  - The nomination must be accompanied by a résumé and written consent of the nominee and signed by three (3) Chapter Officers and one (1) other member in good standing in their Chapter.
- B Self-Nomination by a Volunteer
  - A member may volunteer as a candidate for a position on the Board by forwarding their name to the Nominating Committee up to eight (8) weeks prior to the date of the Annual General Meeting (AGM) in any given year.
  - The nomination must be accompanied by a résumé and written consent of the volunteer and signed by two (2) Chapter
    Officers and two (2) other members in good standing;
- C The nomination must be accompanied by a résumé and written consent of the volunteer and signed by one (1) Branch Officer and two (2) other members in good standing.
