Niagara Falls, October 17, 2023— Canadian Parents for French (Ontario) held its annual provincial conference and 47th Annual General Meeting (AGM) in Niagara Falls October 14-15, 2023. The CPF Board, Staff and Members celebrated CPF Ontario Awards Winners at a special luncheon Saturday the 14th:

- <u>Mlacak Award</u>: 13-year volunteer and CPF ON advocate Alanda Lantz of Hanover received the Mlacak Award for the outstanding contribution to CPF.
- McGillivray Award: Nicole Czaja, a former FSL consultant, educator, Vice Principal for Rainbow District School Board and Past President of OMLTA (2017-18) received the McGillivray Award for outstanding contribution to FSL education; and
- Youth Leadership Award: Anastacia (Ana) Weekes, a Grade 10 student in Brampton and 6-year volunteer with her local chapter received the Youth Leadership Award for outstanding dedication, contributions, and initiative of youth towards FSL programming.
